

GUIDE FOR USERS OF MEDICAL-IMAGING SERVICES

Walk-In Examinations

Some medical-imaging examinations do not require an appointment (general radiography, plain X-rays, or X-rays).

PROCEDURE

- The prescribing physician must hand-deliver the completed medical-imaging prescription to you or tell you where it was sent, to direct you to the right facility.
- You will not receive any calls advising you to come in for your exam.
- You are responsible for going to one of the facilities below for your examination, preferably at the times indicated.
